What does it cover?

Lot 1 - Occupational Health

Occupational Health Services providing Occupational Health advice and Services such as absence management and referral, Work Health Assessments, Ill Health retirement, Immunisations/Vaccinations/Inoculations, Health Surveillance, Counselling and Mental Health Support, physiotherapy, Health and Wellbeing services, COVID-19 Swabbing and Testing Services, COVID-19 Vaccination Service, Trauma & Critical Incident/Wellbeing Services, Staff Training/Upskilling

Lot 2 - EAP (Employee Assistance Programme)

Employee Assistance programmes to provide Contracting Authority employees with help and advice around work and personal matters that may impact on workplace performance. Also includes Workplace Mediation and Management Support, COVID-19 Swabbing and Testing Services, COVID-19 Vaccination Services, Trauma & Critical Incident Management, Staff Training/Upskilling

Lot 4 - Optical Services

Eye care services including eyesight testing for Visual Display Users (VDU), Safety Eye Care services, GOC and Colour vision tests, Voucher Schemes, mobile services

What are the benefits of the Framework Agreement?

Cost Savings

Delivering cost savings through a reduction in staff absence levels, to tackle the estimates from Public Health England put the cost to the **NHS** of staff absence due to poor health at £2.4bn a **year** – accounting for around £1 in **every** £40 of the total budget.
